POSITION SUMMARY FCL invites applications for the position of **Propane Service Department Supervisor** in Saskatoon or Melfort Saskatchewan.

The main functions of this position are to investigate and anticipate customers propane heating needs, analyze options for the work to be performed and find solutions that will work safely and meet all codes and regulations within the gas industry. Schedule and co-ordinate all required service work and installation of propane tanks and equipment that will be completed by department service technicians. Supervise and provide positive leadership, guidance and mentorship to all service technicians while ensuring service work is completed efficiently and safely. Focus is needed on ensuring a consistent high level of customer service is being provided and all customer inquiries and concerns involving propane installations or service work are resolved in a timely manner. Complete administrative tasks, provide assistance to annual budget process and maintain inventory control system for tanks, fittings and propane equipment.

RESPONSIBILITIES Reporting to the Propane Area Manager – Central Sask., responsibilities for this position include the following:

1. Anticipate and investigate customers propane heating needs, analyze options for the work to be performed and find solutions that will work safely and meet all codes and regulations within the gas industry. Once solutions are found make recommendations to customers for installation of required equipment.
2. Schedule and co-ordinate the completion of all required service work and installation of propane tanks and equipment that will be completed by department service technicians ensuring that it is done in an efficient, safe and cost effective manner, while providing a consistently high level of customer service.
3. Ensure all service technicians are adequately trained to perform their duties conforming to the Departments Safety Program and all industry safety procedures, policies and regulations are followed and fully documented. Make compliance adjustments as necessary and set up and review annual training plans for employee's development.
4. Ensure inspections are being completed and documented on all required propane facilities and any deficiencies found are being corrected in a timely manner.
5. Ensure a cost effective preventive maintenance program is being performed on all FCL Propane Service Department equipment and rolling stock and all required inspections are completed and documented in the departments filing system.
6. Ensure all customer inquiries or concerns involving propane installations or service work are resolved and handled in an efficient and timely manner.
7. When necessary take part in the apprenticeship program by apprenticing gasfitter apprentice(s). Adhere to all of the requirements of this program to ensure the apprentice is mentored and trained in an acceptable manner.
8. Complete daily administrative tasks including weekly and monthly reports, and assist Area Manager with annual budget process. Maintain inventory control system for tanks, fittings and propane equipment.
9. Other duties as assigned.
