NOTES

Note 1: Subsection 31(4) of the *TDG Act* stipulates that any non-compliance with the conditions of this equivalency certificate causes the provisions of the *TDG Act* and *TDG Regulations* to apply as though this equivalency certificate did not exist.

Note 2: This equivalency certificate provides no regulatory relief other than specifically stated herein. Therefore, all other requirements of the *TDG Act* and the *TDG Regulations* apply.

PURPOSE

(The following is for information purposes only and is not part of the certificate.)

This equivalency certificate authorizes the certificate holder to display requalification marks in a manner that does not comply with CSA B339-18. Cylinders requalified in accordance with this equivalency certificate are marked on a new metal plate that is attached to the valve-protection collar of the cylinders by riveting. The certificate holder has demonstrated that when used under the conditions stipulated herein, the cylinders could be used with an equivalent level of safety.

CONDITIONS

This equivalency certificate authorizes the members of the **Canadian Propane Association** to handle, offer for transport or transport and authorizes **any person** to handle, offer for transport, transport, or import into Canada, by road vehicle, by railway vehicle, by vessel on a domestic voyage or by aircraft, cylinders in a manner that does not comply with:

- subparagraph 5.10(1)(a)(ii) of the TDG Regulations,
- subparagraph 5.10(1)(b)(iii) of the TDG Regulations,
- subparagraph 5.10(1)(c)(ii) of the TDG Regulations, and
- subparagraph 5.10(1)(d)(iii) of the TDG Regulations,

if the following conditions are met:

- (a) Subject to condition (b) of this equivalency certificate, the requirements in CSA B340-18 are complied with;
- (b) The cylinders contain only the following dangerous goods:
 - UN1075, LIQUEFIED PETROLEUM GASES; or PETROLEUM GASES, LIQUEFIED, Class 2.1, or
 - UN1978, PROPANE, Class 2.1;
- (c) Subject to conditions (d) to (f) of this equivalency certificate, each cylinder is requalified in accordance with CSA B339-18;
- (d) Each cylinder is requalified by visual reinspection only in accordance with Clause 24.2.9 of CSA B339-18;
- (e) Each cylinder meets the definition in Clause 3 of CSA B339-18 of a series-4 container:
- (f) Despite Clause 24.6.1.1 of CSA B339-18, following requalification, each cylinder shall be plainly and permanently marked in accordance with Clauses 24.6.2, 24.6.3 and 24.6.4 of CSA B339-18 on a new metal plate, which may be riveted to a permanently attached valve-protection collar. The size of the requalification marks shall be in accordance with Clause 4.19.5 of CSA B339-18 and the plate shall not obscure the original manufacturer's marks;
- (g) The Canadian Propane Association ensures that a copy of this equivalency certificate is provided to all members of the Canadian Propane Association;

(h) The certificate holder, cylinder owner, or user reports any incident involving loss of contents or failure of the cylinders to the Executive Director, Regulatory Frameworks and International Engagement, Regulatory Affairs Branch, Transportation of Dangerous Goods Directorate, Transport Canada.
