- Canadian-made **renewable propane is a drop-in fuel** that lowers lifecycle emissions using existing propane infrastructure.



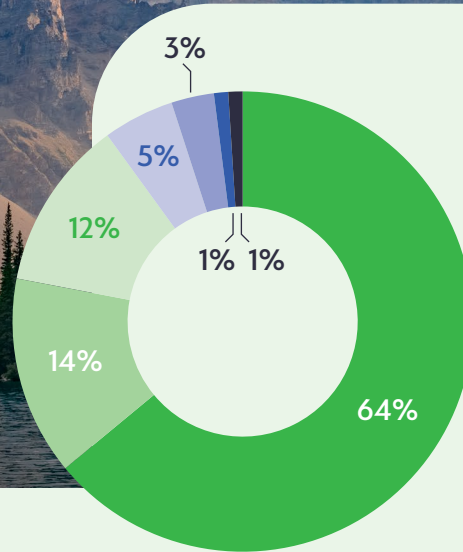
## Propane protects energy affordability

## Propane production hits record levels

Alberta is **Canada's propane production engine, adding about 46 thousand barrels per day since 2018** as natural gas development, particularly in the Montney region, continues to expand. This growth reinforces Alberta's role in a reliable, competitively price propane supply.



## Propane supports oil and gas sector

Nearly half of Alberta's propane demand—49% in 2024—is driven by the mining and oil and gas sector, making it the province's largest source of propane use.
